
Eisenhower Influenza Trends

(As of 11/22/22)

Oct. 1 – Nov. 21, 2022

1,202 total influenza cases

- +393 cases (49% increase) since last week's update on 11/16/22
- 56% flu cases are ≤18 years old
- Influenza A = 1,191 cases
- 57 Inpatient
- 1,145 outpatient



Eisenhower Health is experiencing a record number of influenza and RSV cases – the highest numbers in the past 5 years for the months of October and November



Eisenhower Influenza Predictions

(As of 11/22/22)

Model Predictions:


- +3,122 additional flu cases over next month
- 1,221 current flu cases
- Predicted total: 4,343
 total flu cases by 12/31
 for Eisenhower Health
 only (Solid blue line)

Confidence Range:

Lower limit (LCL) = 2,996

Upper limit (UCL) = 5,691

(Dotted lines on graph)






Eisenhower RSV Trends

(As of 11/22/22)

Oct. 1 – Nov. 21, 2022

- 384 total RSV cases
 - +69 cases (22% increase) since last week's update on 11/16/22
 - 37 inpatient; 347 outpatient
 - 90% RSV cases in ages ≤18 years
 - 73% RSV cases in 0-4 age group

Eisenhower RSV Predictions

(As of 11/22/22)

Model Predictions:

- +453 additional RSV cases over next month
- 413 current RSV cases
- Predicted total: 866 total RSV cases by 12/31 for Eisenhower Health only (Solid blue line)

Confidence Range:

Lower limit (LCL) = 588 Upper limit (UCL) = 1,143 (Dotted lines on graph)
