in Supreme Court history, sent a letter of resignation to President Johnson about the time the court completed its 1967-68 term on Monday.

The White House had no immediate comment. Warren's office said the chief justice does not comment on such matters. Among those mentioned as possible successors to Warren was Associate Justice Abe Fortas, a longtime confident of the Chief Executive who has continued that relationship since Johnson appointed him to the Court last year.

It was not learned whether Warren specified a date on which he wanted to step down from the nation's highest judicial post, to which President Dwight D. Eisenhower appointed him Oct. 1, 1953.

In his 15 terms as Chief Justice, Warren has presided over a Court that has handed down decisions that have drastically altered the nation's approach to school segregation, the rural-city ratio in state legislatures, religious practices such as prayer in public schools and the rights of individuals arrested by the police.
