Incident Update: * Incident Update: Incident QR Code	The Rabbit Fire had minimal activity throughout the daytime operational period, with smoldering in heavy fuels. Fire crews built containment lines and patrolled for hot spots and will continue through the night. Extreme heat and low humidity are forecasted for the next operational period. High temperatures, steep terrain and difficult access continue to hamper fire suppression efforts. Hazards remain present for critical infrastructure, radio repeater towers and natural gas and petroleum pipelines.
