I am excited to announce that The Rancho Mirage High School Band & Instrumental Music Program will be Touring Japan 2024. We are projected to have 90 students from our Symphonic Band, Jazz Ensemble, Concert Choir, Percussion Ensemble, and String Orchestra attend the WorldStrides International Music Tour scheduled June 12<sup>th</sup>-June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2024. The students will visit and perform in Tokyo, Hiroshima, Osaka, Kyoto, and Hakone.

This is the 1<sup>st</sup>International Tour for the Band. The cost of each student is \$6,500 which includes airfare, hotel, meals, festival fees, and transportation. Our Music Program has been working hard to fully fund our festival with fundraisers, sponsorships, and donations. However, we still have a way to go.

As the Director of Bands at Rancho Mirage High School, it is my goal to improve the lives of all students through providing academic opportunities that are not typically available. This tour will give our students exposure to some of the most historical locations in the world.
